The student has to acquire the following final competences by preparing and defending his master's dissertation: the student has to be able to

- 1. Define a research problem;
- 2. Formulate clear research questions and hypotheses;
- 3. Set up an appropriate methodology;
- 4. Carry out a critical literature study;
- 5. Collect quality data meticulously (using existing data sets or data obtained by lab or field work and/or surveys);
- 6. Process data in a correct way;
- 7. Analyze data in a critical way;
- 8. Make a concise synthesis;
- 9. Draw up a final manuscript scientific report, which includes taking into account all formal aspects of the final manuscript with respect to construction of the dissertation, language and style, figures and tables, references;
- 10. Show the necessary independence, motivation, dedication and initiative while obtaining final competences 1-9;
- 11. Give a clear oral presentation of the results of the work;
- 12. Argue in a well founded manner during the discussion.
