

Navigating Lump Sum Funding in Erasmus+

A non-exhaustive and evolving list of resources – November 2024

A lot of information related to the Lump Sum funding model is published in the context of its use in Horizon Europe funded projects. Whereas the general principles of Lump Sum funding are equally applicable across EU funding programmes, important nuances in the framework of the Erasmus+ programme exist as well.

Nevertheless, some of the general information, or materials developed in the context of Horizon Europe, can also contribute to understanding the ins and outs of this funding model. This non-exhaustive list therefore aims to offer a starting point to provide insights into the Lump Sum funding model, which can be leveraged when designing and managing an Erasmus+ Lump Sum funded project. Keep in mind that nuances must be made between action types that are under direct management (EACEA) or indirect management (National Agencies), following the information and instructions that are available for each.
