MARY ANNING

"The most eminent female fossilist"

Born on May 21, 1799 Mary Anning became one of the most remarkable and renowned fossil hunters of her age. Her start in life was ordinary enough being the daughter of a carpenter who lived in Lyme Regis on the coast of Dorset.

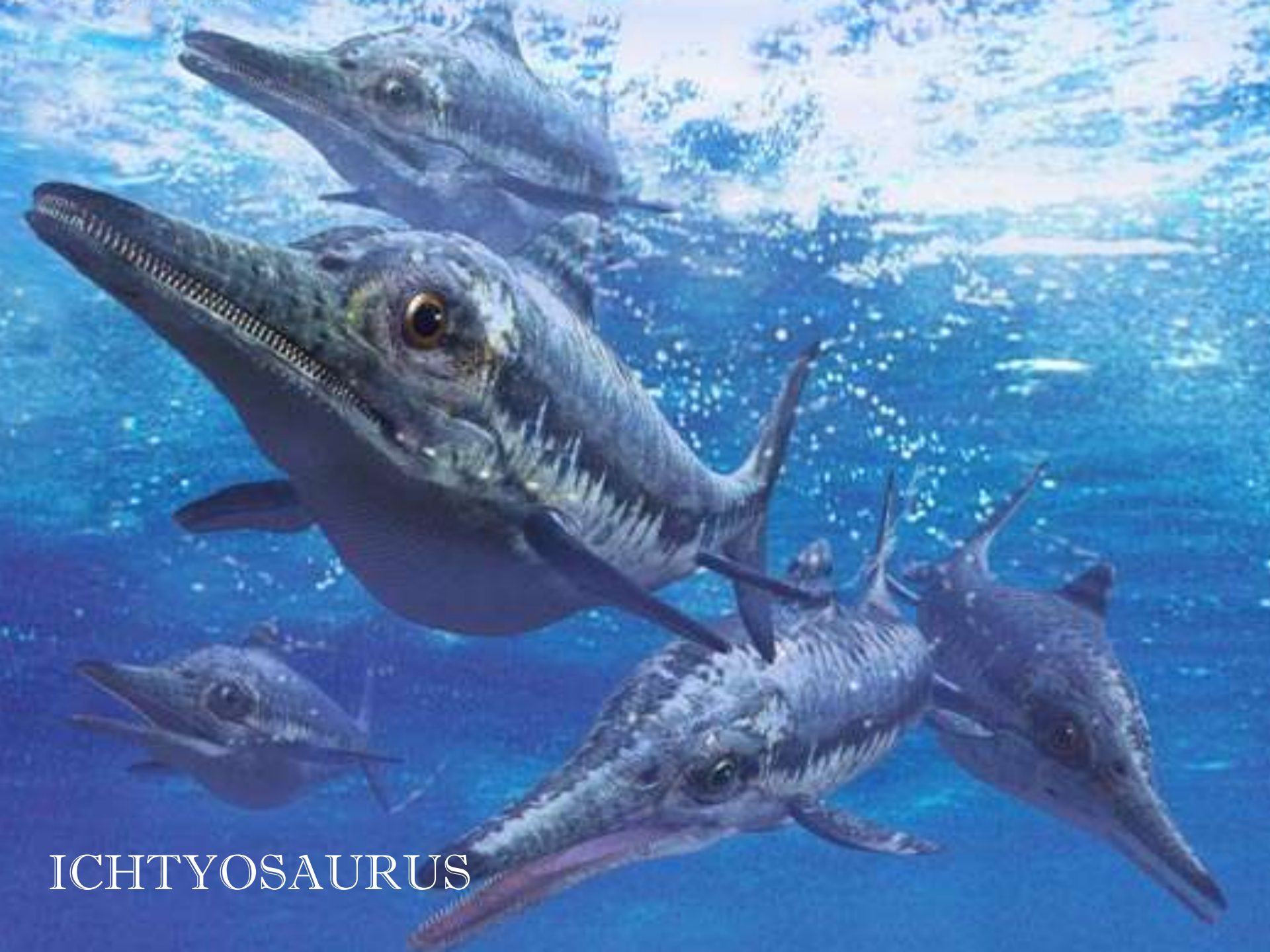
Indeed she was described as a "dull and taciturn child" until an extraordinary incident on August 18, 1805. Whilst sheltering under a tree from a storm three women and the baby Mary were struck by lightning! The three women were killed and it was at first thought that Mary was dead as well. However on being bathed in water she revived. Mary is described as lively and intelligent after this incident.

The Anning's were a poor family and Richard, Mary's father, supplemented his income with some fossil collecting and selling from his shop. On his many fossil hunting trips along the beach and cliffs in the Lyme Regis area he took the young Mary. Then in 1810 Richard fell badly whilst out on the cliffs. The fall combined with tuberculosis caused his death.

Mary's mother, who was very religious, forbade Mary to go fossil hunting. However, shortly after this Mary was returning with a full armload when a woman stopped her and offered her half-prown for the specimen. This fired Mary's enthusiasm for collection.

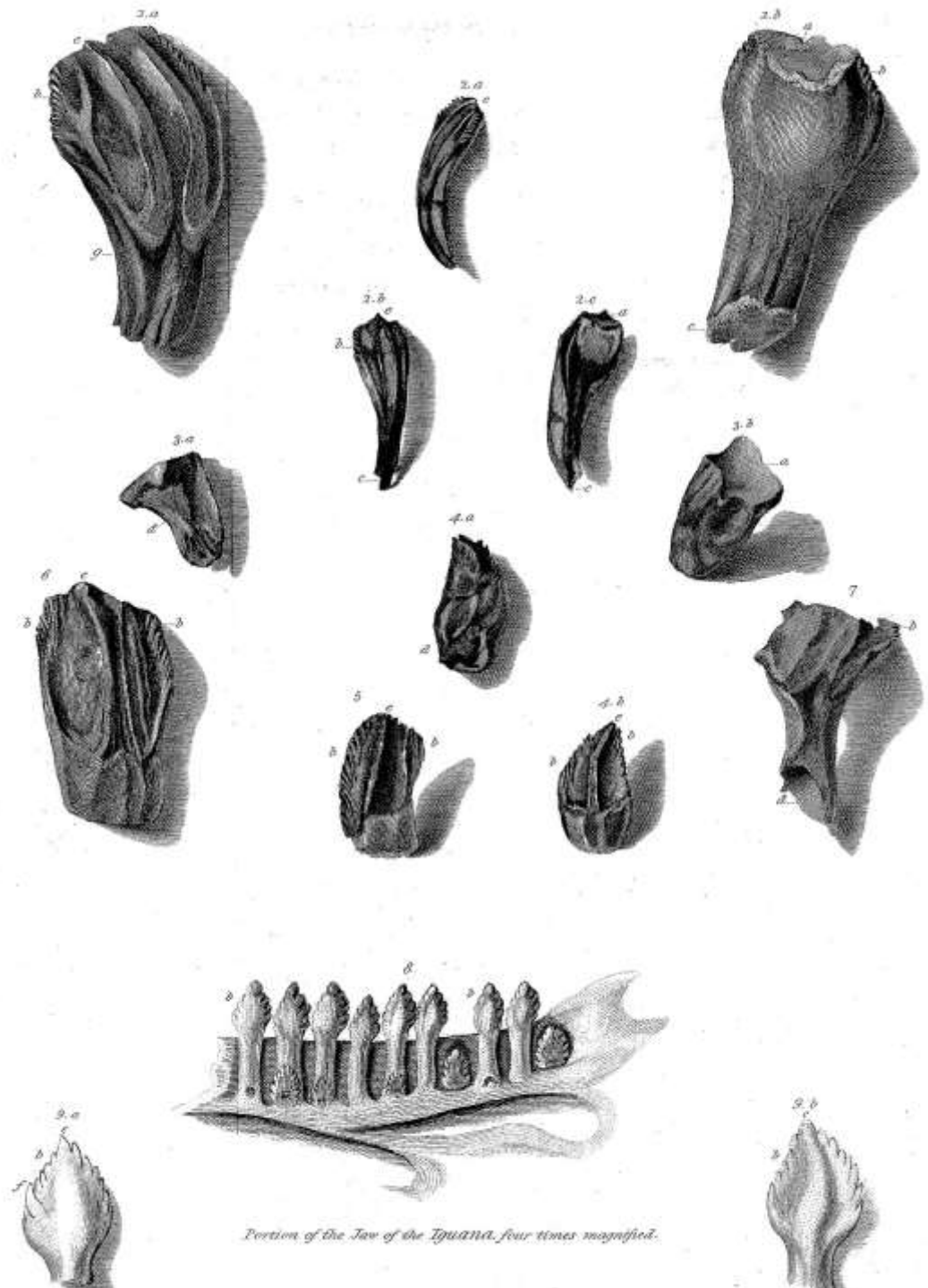
