So, you enrolled in our Buddy Programme? Great decision! We're glad to have you! The Buddy Programme is here to help you in several ways:

#### a. Get acquainted with local students

The first and most obvious way to support you, is of course by pairing you up with one (or more) of our local students. In doing so, we hope to provide you with a peer who knows what it's like to be a student at Ghent University and in Ghent. Through their own experiences they can help and advise you.

The matching process for our Buddy Programme is designed to ensure that both you and your buddy have a truly enriching experience. We carefully consider shared interests, expectations, and fields of study to pair you with a local student who shares similar passions. This thoughtful matching helps both you and your buddy to benefit from the programme.

It's important to remember that our local students volunteer to be buddies because they are genuinely excited to welcome you. #### b. Meet other international students

- **Study support**: access to academic assistance, including study tips, study sessions, and guidance on finding additional help if needed.
- WhatsApp group: inclusion in a group chat with other students in the programme to ask questions, share experiences and arrange meetups.

#### How you're paired

The pairing process for the Buddy Programme is thoughtfully conducted by our dedicated buddy coordinators. While nationality is not a significant factor in the pairing process, it may be considered if some buddies express a desire to improve their skills in a particular language.
